A. Ministers Received, Removed, and Transferred.

- Robert Allen was received from the Presbytery of Detroit and began his services Feb 1st as a Stated Supply Pastor at Hemenway Memorial Presbyterian Church of Boonville.
- An At-large Minister, Amy Ramirez-Spears, was removed from the ministerial roll of the Presbytery by the Committee on Ministry, in accordance with G-2.0508.

B. Deaths. The Presbytery notes the death of the Rev. Charles F. Pye on December 31, 2020.

C. Session Minutes Review: Procedures have been established for this year's Review of Session Minutes. Prior to the Assembly meeting, the instructions and form for review of Session minutes and registers will be sent to clerks of session.

D. Monroe City Church bell remains at the Indiana Vincennes Church manse: There is one church within the Presbytery who is exploring options to have the bell moved to their location.

E. Presbytery Judicial Process. An Investigating Committee, appointed by the Moderator of the Presbytery in July 2020 to look into allegations of misconduct by a minister member of the Presbytery, has concluded no charges will be brought forward. The IC has been dismissed with thanks.

F. Business Entity Reports being filed with the Secretary of State's Office: There remain several Churches who have lost their legal corporation status with the state of Indiana—having failed to timely file updated Business Entity Reports every 2 years. It is essential that churches file these reports and, if corporation status is lost, must begin the process to get it reestablished. Treasurer Jean Brown and Stephanie Worden at the Presbytery Office will be available to help churches learn the procedures for reinstatement.

G. Reminder: Each church, when renewing their property insurance, must ask their insurer to add "The Presbytery of Ohio Valley" as an additional insured party so that the relationship of the church to the Presbytery is documented with the insurance company.

Report of the Presbytery Council

The Rev. Susan McGhee, Moderator

For Presbytery's Information

The Council conducted an electronic vote on December 12, 2020, and took the following action:

- Acting as a Commission of the Presbytery, appointed David Crittenden as Temporary Stated Clerk during Joe Kimmel's recovery.

The Council met January 27, 2021, by videoconference and took the following actions:

- Acted on matters related to the remaining monies in the Lilly Economic Challenge Grant account
 - Renamed the fund "The Charlie Pye Fund for Excellence in Ministry."
 - Appointed Mary McClellan, Dave Crittenden, and Susan McGhee to develop and propose to Council protocols for the administration of the fund going forward
 - Authorized Mary McClellan, Dave Crittenden, and Susan McGhee to serve as administrators of the fund in the interim.
- Elected Catherine Knott and Alicia Holt as at-large members of the Personnel Committee

The Council conducted an electronic vote on February 4, 2021, and took the following actions:

- Approved a letter to be sent to sessions and pastors with guidance concerning in-person worship
- Approved a request from Pyoca that the Presbytery Council subsidize the "easter in a basket" kits at \$10 per box, with a limit of 250 boxes.
- In response to communication with the Clerk of Session of Grace Presbyterian Church, Clarksville, indicating that the congregation wishes to dissolve:
 - Acting as a commission of the Presbytery, called a meeting of the Session and Congregation of the Grace Presbyterian Church at a time and date acceptable to those involved, to act on matters related to the dissolution of the congregation and corporation.
 - Authorized Susan McGhee to serve as moderator of session and congregation until an administrative commission is put in place
 - Authorized David Crittenden to represent the Presbytery as needed until an administrative commission is put in place
