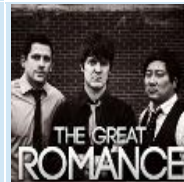

Proposed Form of Government Revisions: New Schedule for Education and Deliberation

At the September 9 Assembly, it was suggested that Council reschedule the POV's consideration of the proposed New Form of Government, in order to provide more time for education and conversation. Council met by conference call the Monday following Assembly, and has decided: 1) to schedule our deliberation and vote on the new Form of Government for the March 5, 2011, Assembly, and 2) to provide a two-hour session on the new Form of Government at 10:00 Eastern Time (9:00 Central Time) on Thursday, December 2. This is the morning of our December Assembly, which is scheduled to be an afternoon meeting. Susan McGhee and Larry Jackman will lead this event, which will be designed to help those who wish to explore the new Form of Government proposal further, as well as provide resources for ministers and elders who wish to offer similar educational opportunities in their congregations and clusters.
